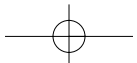

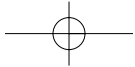

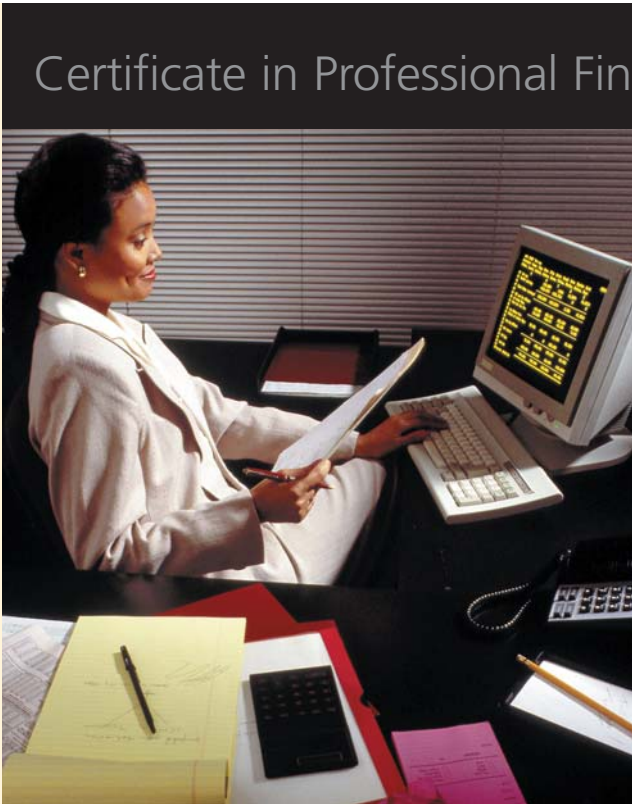




## Certificate Program

The Graduate Certificate in Professional Financial Management is ideal for individuals who expect to exercise control over the financial functions of their companies. It is also a valuable asset for general managers who wish to strengthen their knowledge and skills in the financial management of their organizations. To qualify for an NJCU certificate in Professional Financial Management, the following courses (18 credits) must be taken:

- **Decision Analysis**
- **Accounting for Entities**
- **Accounting for Managers**
- **Behavioral Issues and Ethics in Management**
- **Working Capital Management**
- **Global Strategic Management**



# Certificate in Professional Financial Management at NJCU

## Admission Requirements

To enroll in the Certificate in Professional Financial Management Program, you must hold a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited university or college with a minimum 2.75 GPA on a 4 point scale, and submit:

- **Transcripts from educational institutions you have attended.**
- **A 250 to 500 word essay outlining why you wish to enroll in the program.**
- **Two letters of recommendation from people who know the quality of your work and your character.**
- **Completed applications for Graduate Study and Matriculation Form.**
- **A copy of your résumé.**

If you are accepted, you may be required to submit proof of vaccinations or other health documents as required by state law.

## Tuition
